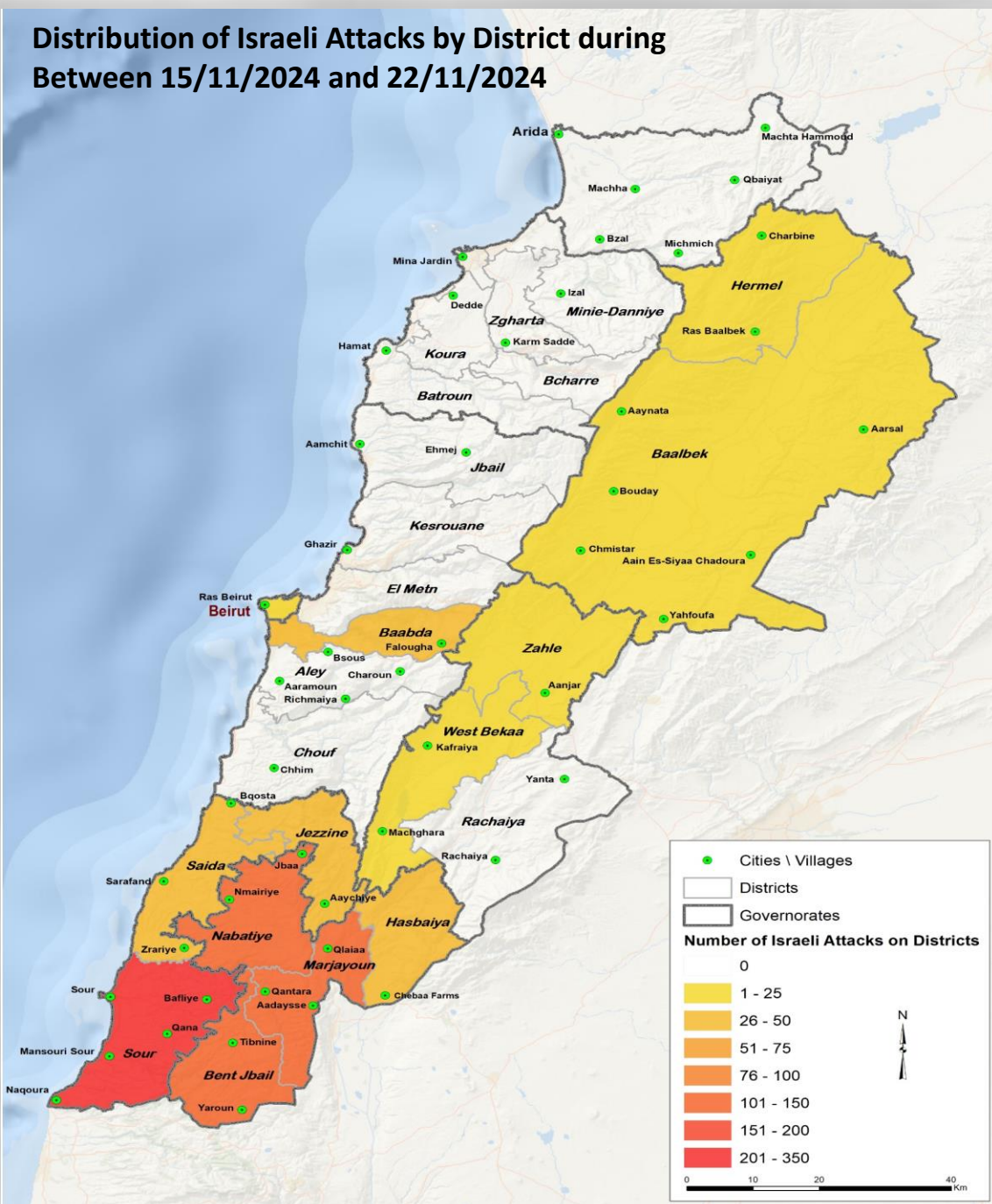
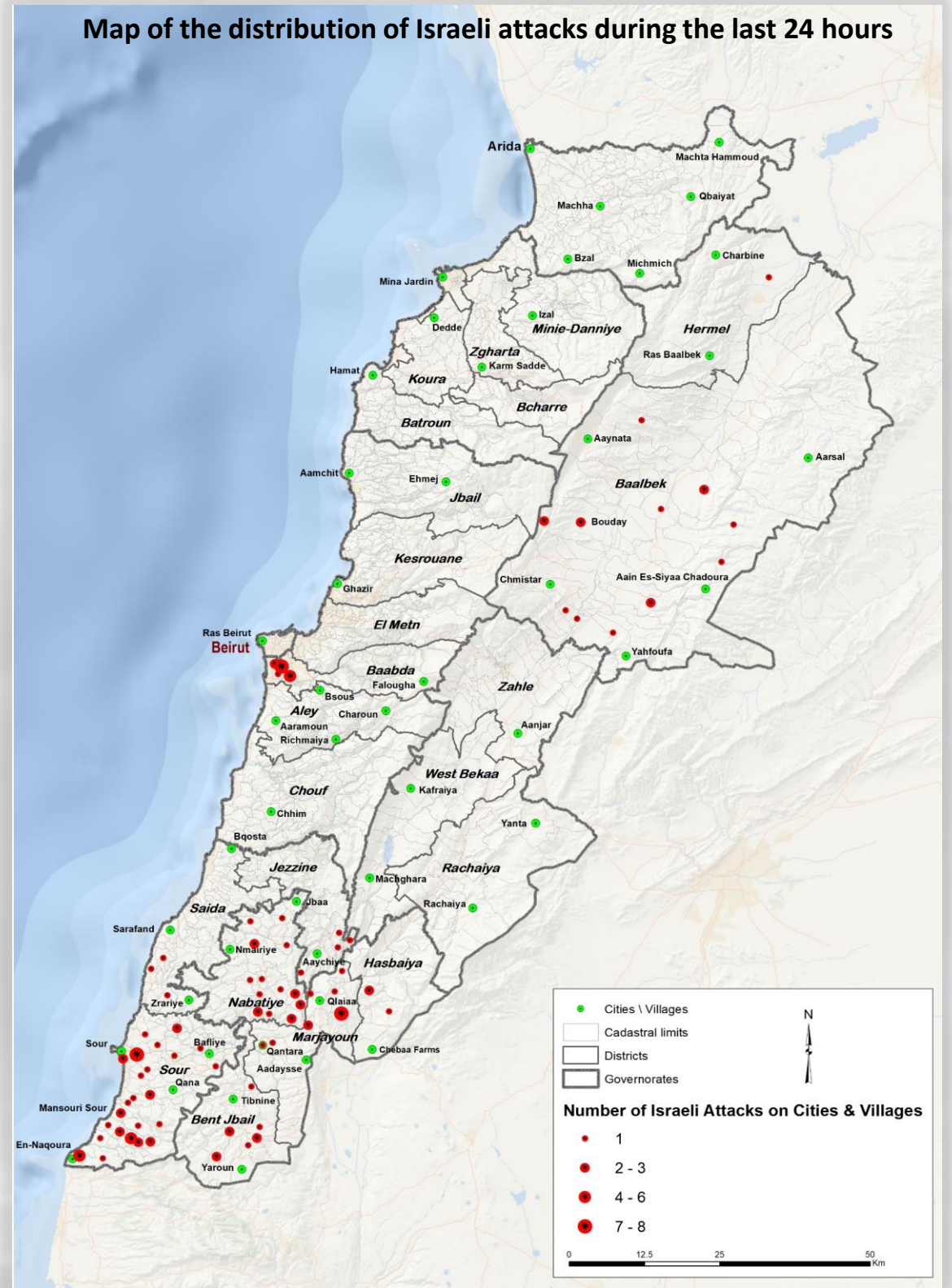
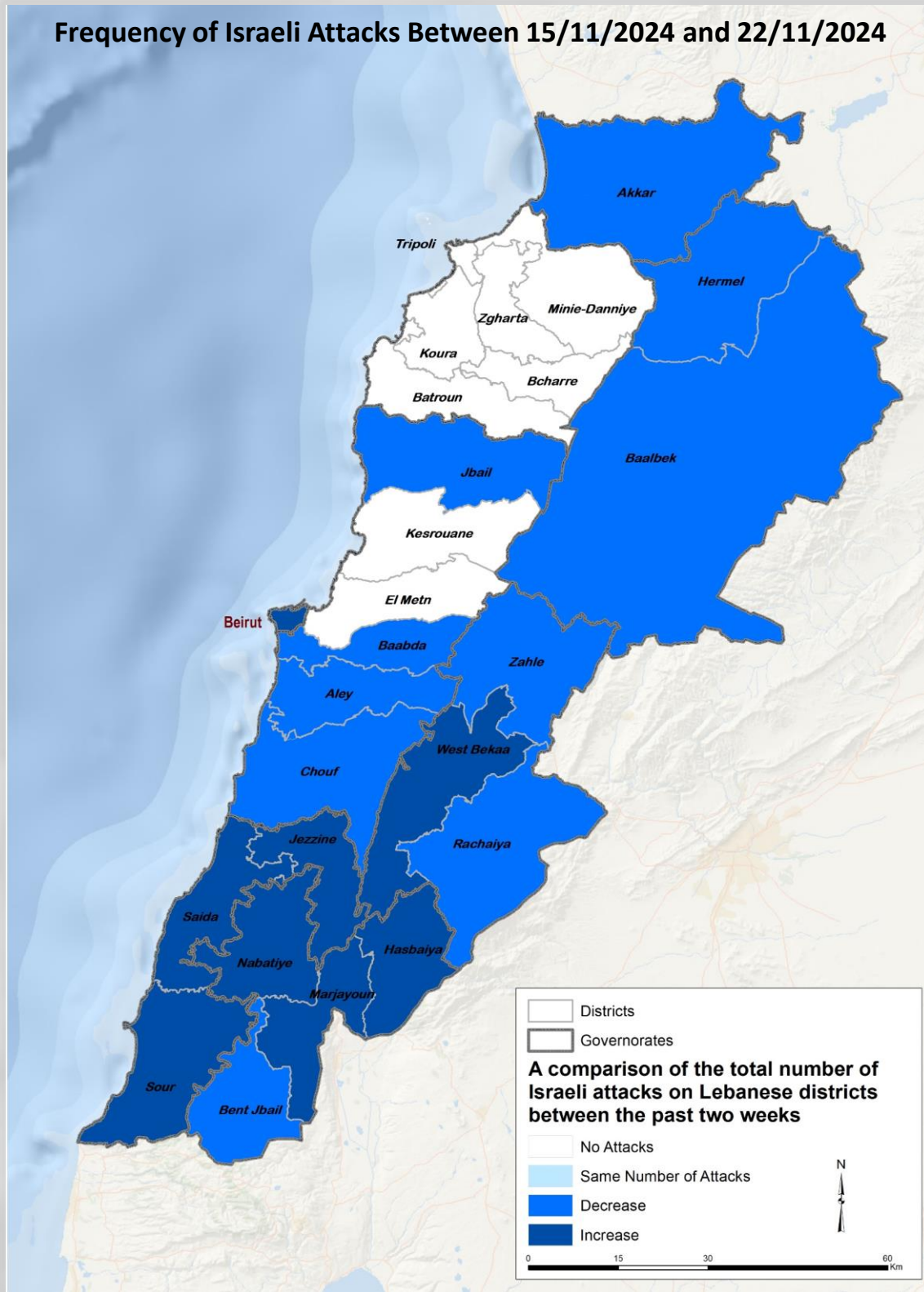


SITUATION OVERVIEW

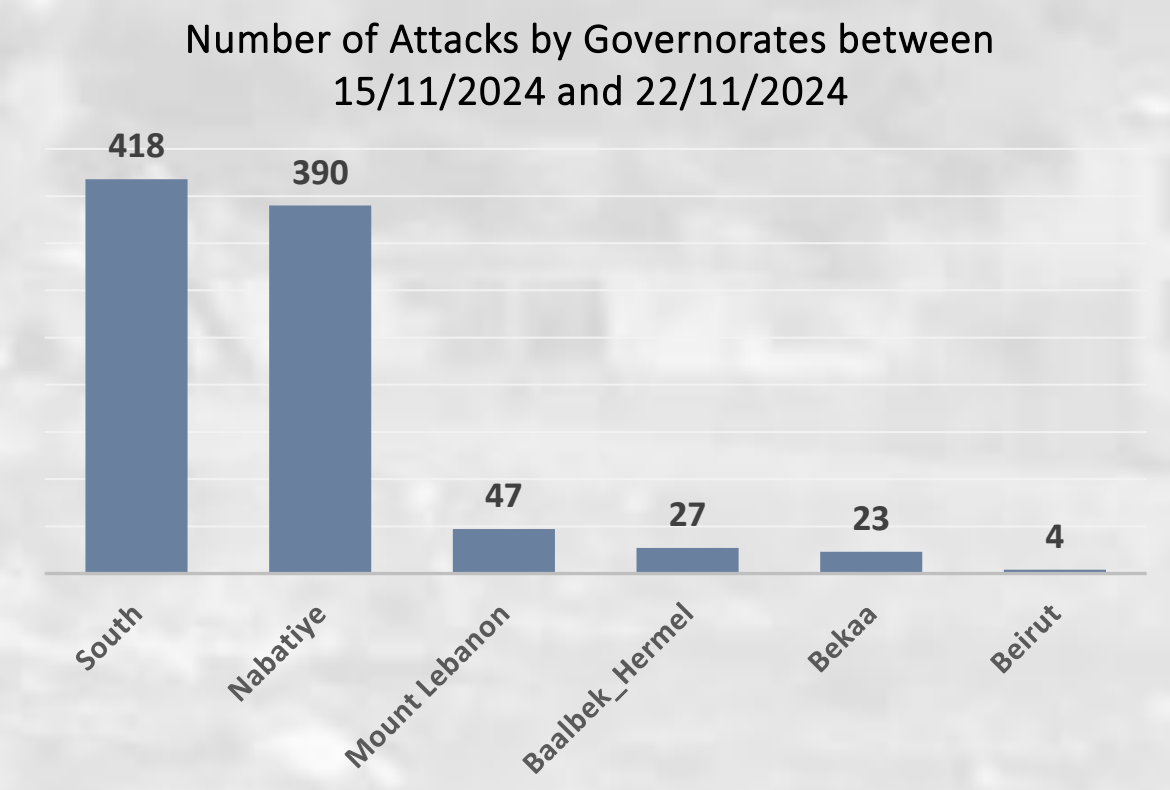
- During the last 24 hours, **134** airstrikes and shelling were recorded on various areas of Lebanon, mostly concentrated in the south (**54** strikes), Nabatiyeh (**48** strikes), Baalbek-Hermel (**17** strikes) and Mount Lebanon (**15** strikes), bringing the total number of attacks since the beginning of the aggression to **13,976**.
- The Ministry of Public Health issued the toll of martyrs and wounded during the last 24 hours, where **59** martyrs and **112** wounded were recorded, bringing the total number since the start of the aggression to **3,642** martyrs and **15,356** wounded.
- According to the report issued by the Ministry of Public Health on 20/11/2024, the number of martyrs among **children** reached **231** martyrs and **1,346** injured, and **women 674** martyrs and **2,697** injured. In the **health sector**, the total number reached **214** martyrs and **321** injured.
- To date, the total number of IDPs has reached **1,237,892** in and outside shelters, of whom **190,102** are in shelters and **1,047,790** are outside shelters.
- The number of accredited shelters reached **1,177**, including **720** public and private educational institutions, where **976** centers reached their maximum capacity.
- From September 23 to November 22, 2024, General Security recorded the crossing of **390,656** Syrian citizens and **234,242** Lebanese citizens into Syrian territory.
- All **security agencies** maintain security, contribute to assisting the displaced, distributing food and fuel, protecting shelters, preventing monopolies, controlling prices, and monitoring and controlling borders.
- Based on the **Cabinet's decision** to allocate a treasury advance of \$ **10 million** to finance the plan to purchase diesel oil for shelters, providing 16 million liters of diesel within four months, the **Ministry of Energy and Water** launched yesterday the mechanism for distributing diesel for heating and electricity generation in shelters in coordination with the ministries represented in the joint committee on this subject, namely the Ministry of Education and Higher Education, the Ministry of Social Affairs, the Ministry of Interior and Municipalities, the Ministry of Finance and the Disaster Management Unit.
- The **Minister of Interior and Municipalities** circulated to the General Directorate of the Internal Security Forces to take all necessary legal measures to prevent the establishment or expansion of camps for displaced Syrians near the course of the Litani River in the governorates of Baalbek-Hermel and Bekaa.
- The **Ministry of Communications** announced that on Thursday 21/11/2024, Alfa and Touch will provide a free package of **20GB** to **130,255 teachers and students** in public schools whose names are listed in the regulations of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education, through their accredited centers in all Lebanese regions or through the websites and applications of the two companies. A similar service is being provided to professors and students at the Lebanese University.
- The Ministry of Public Health launched the national influenza vaccination campaign, in cooperation with UNICEF and the World Health Organization.
- The **Army** issued a statement on 18/11/2024 on the arrival of an **Italian** plane carrying an ambulance mechanism provided by the Italian authorities and the Military-Technical Committee for Lebanon. On 21/11/2024, the Directorate issued a statement on the arrival of a food and medical aid plane for the army from the **Russian Federation**.
- A **Kuwaiti** military aircraft arrived this week at Rafic Hariri International Airport in Beirut as part of the air bridge set up by the State of Kuwait to relief the Lebanese people, carrying 40 tons of humanitarian and relief aid provided by the Kuwaiti Red Crescent.

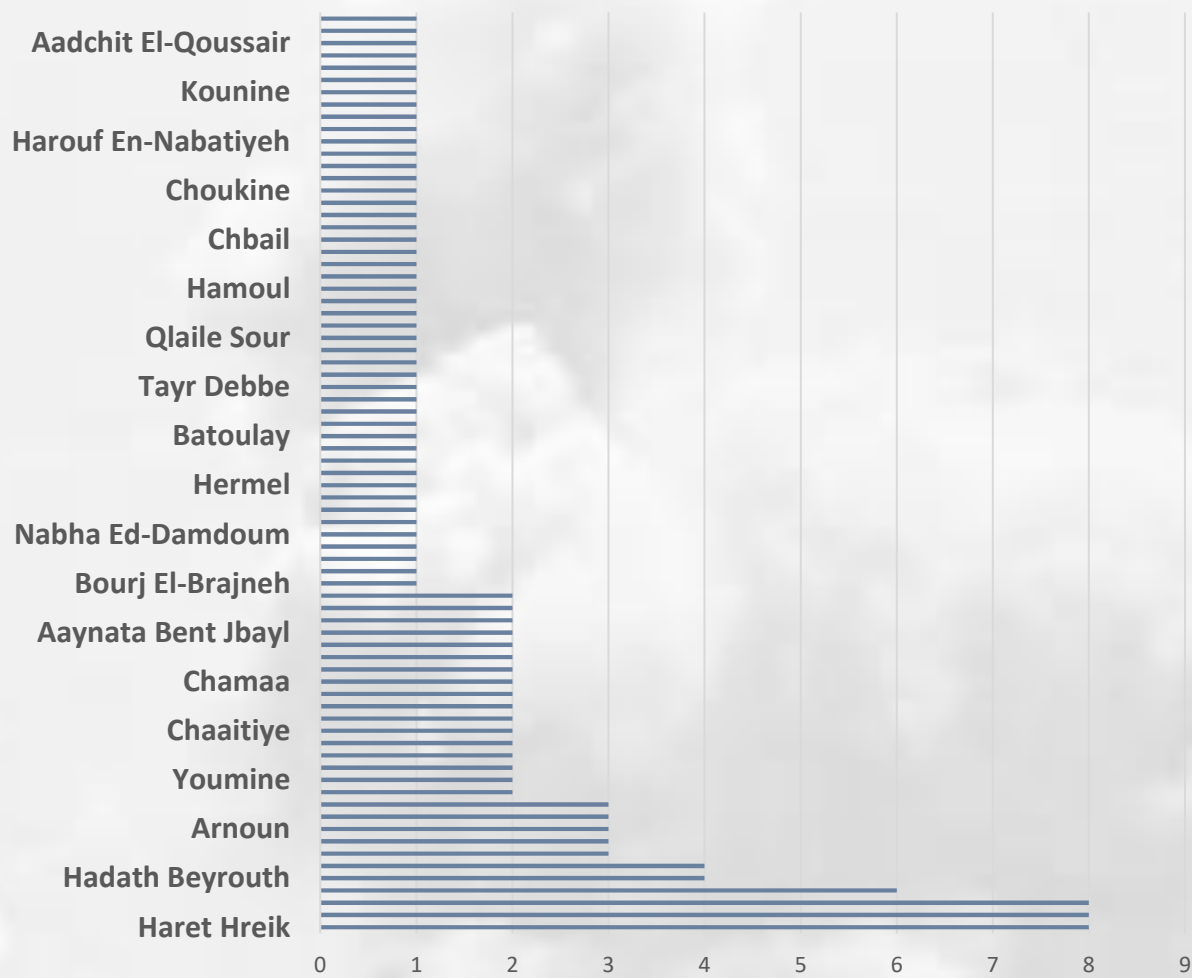

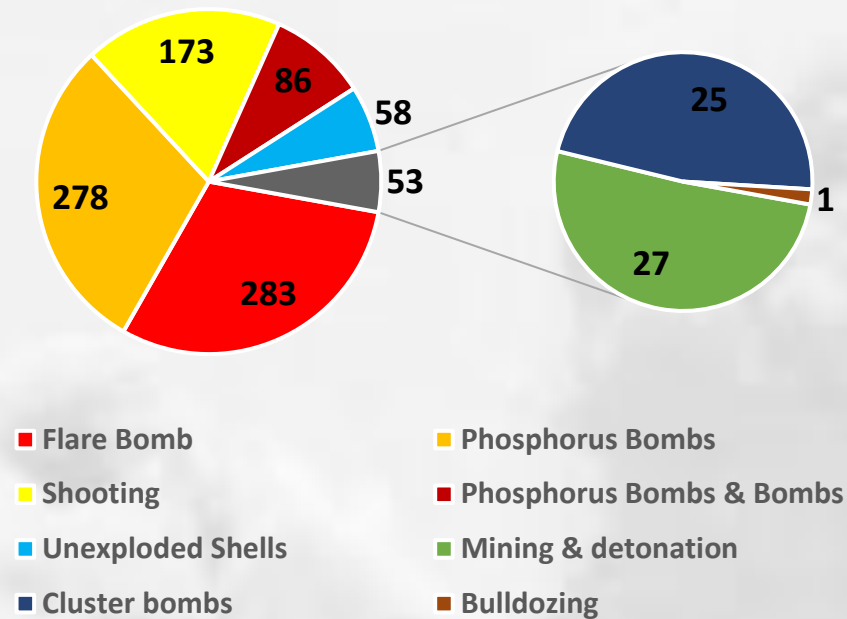

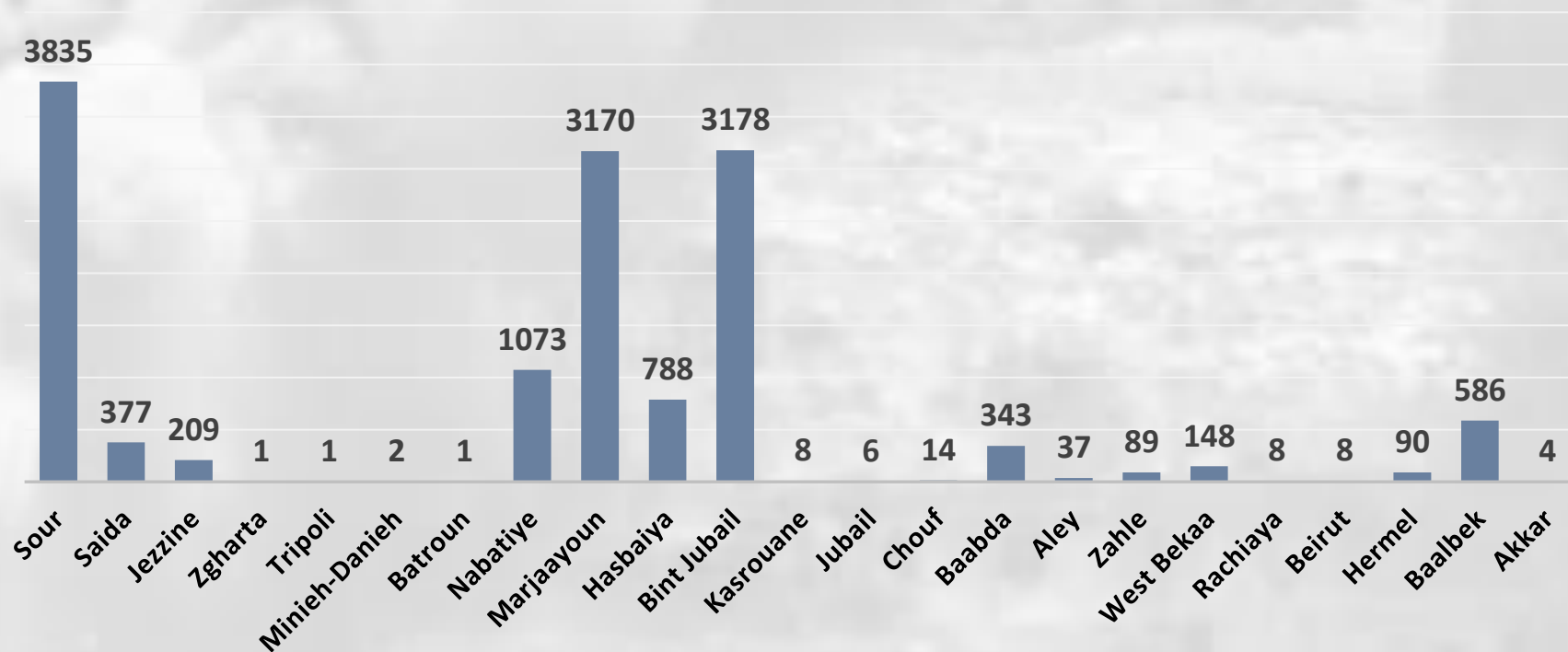
Number of attacks per region in the last 24 hours



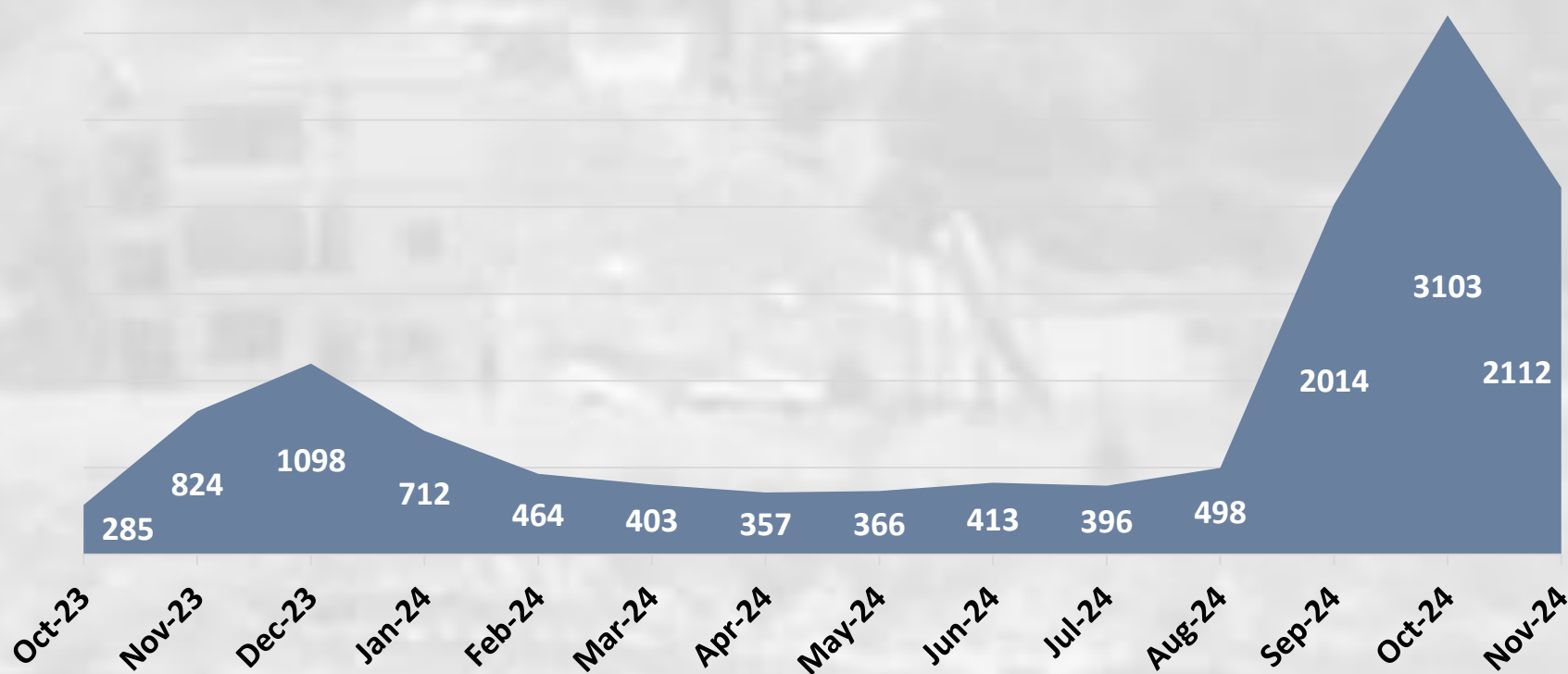
Israeli Attacks as well as Airstrikes Since the Beginning of the Aggression



Number of attacks per casa since the beginning of aggression

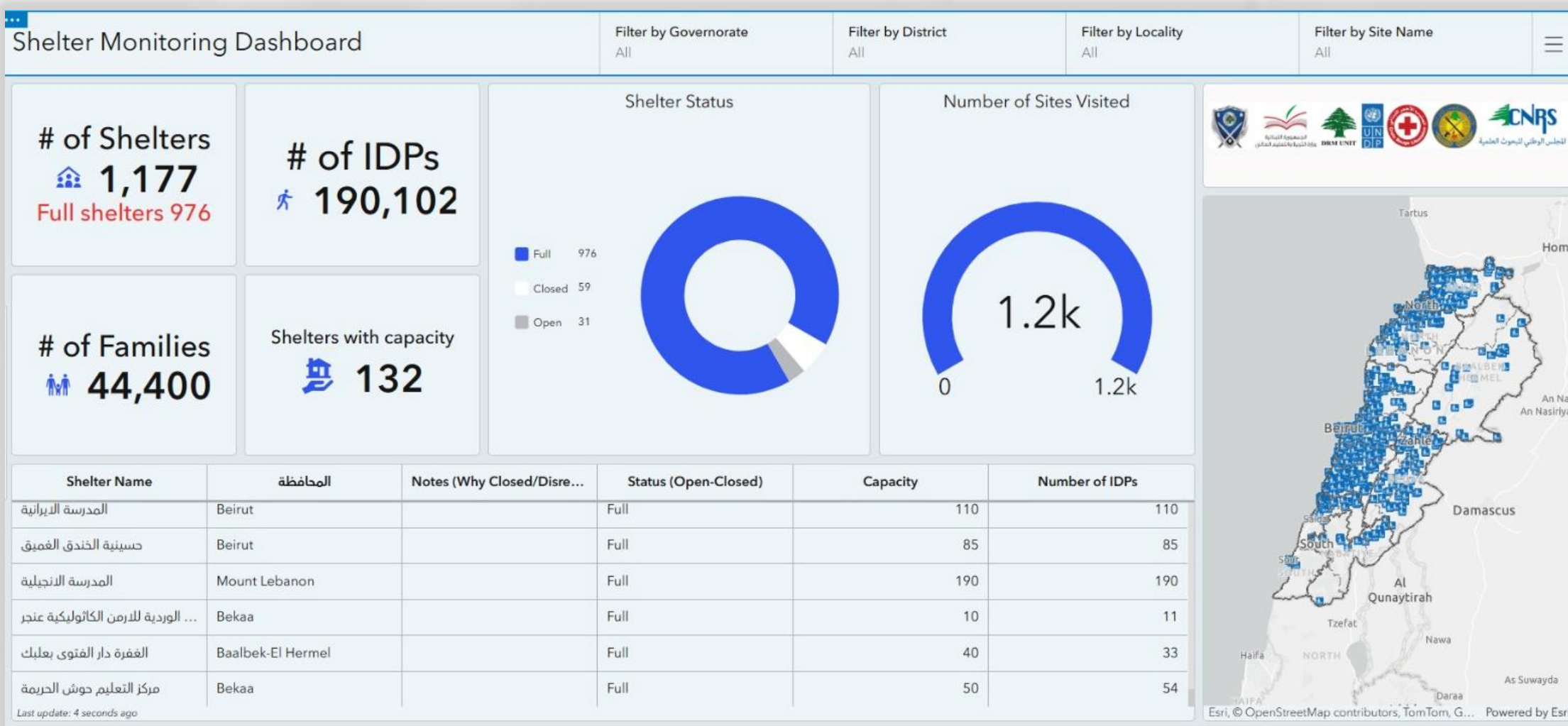


Monthly frequency of attacks since the beginning of aggression



INTERNAL DISPLACEMENT MOVEMENT

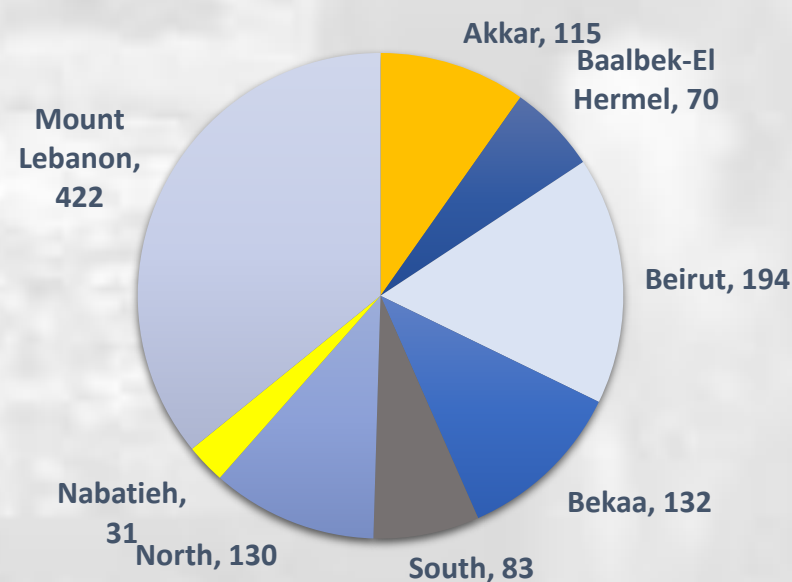

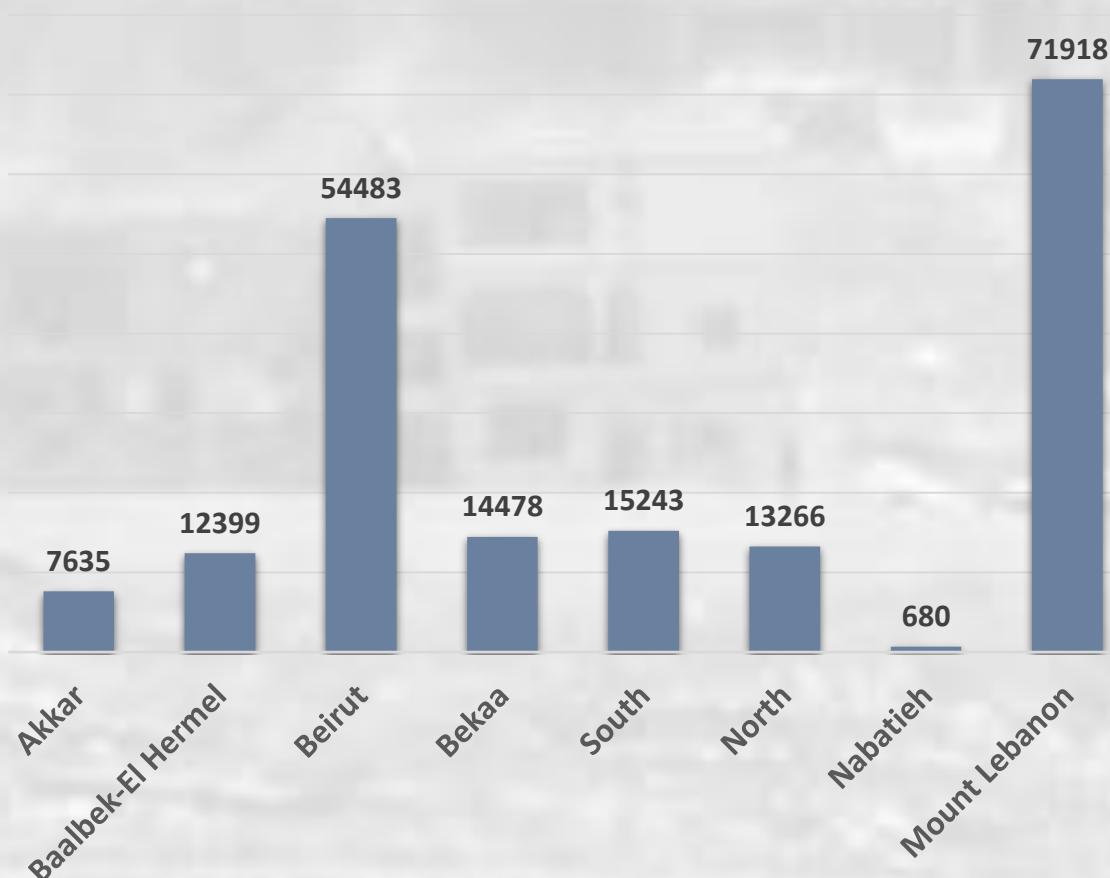

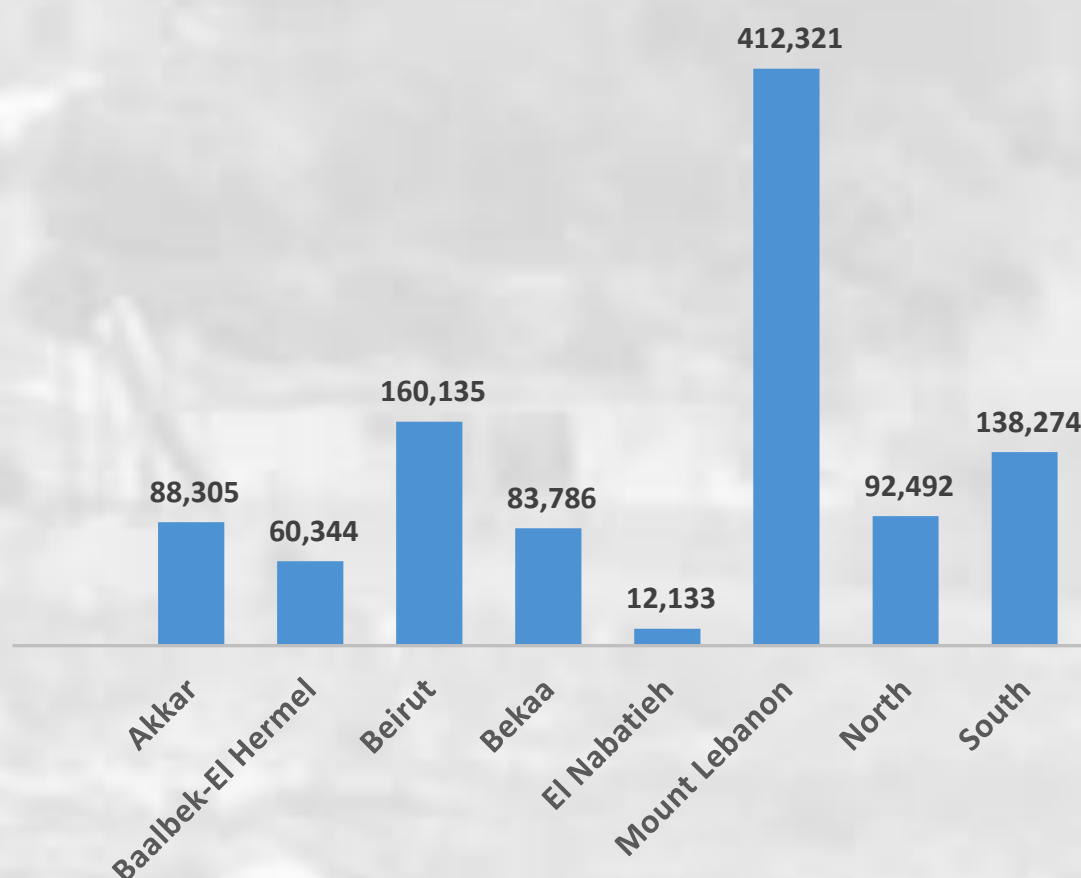
Number of Sites Per Governorate

RESPONSE OF OFFICIAL ADMINISTRATIONS (BETWEEN 15/11/2024 AND 22/11/2024)



- The Minister of Education and Higher Education, in cooperation with the Minister of
- Communication launch of a free internet package for teachers and learners.
- The Directorate General of Education has completed the start of the school year, and the number of students enrolled in formal education to date has reached 262,000 students. Education scenarios varied from face-to-face education in public schools that were not used as shelters and some other buildings that received formal education students to distance education in unsafe areas.
- The Directorate General of Vocational and Technical Education announced the start of teaching in 168 official vocational schools, of which 122 are based on distance education and 11,000 teachers are currently teaching, of whom 7,000 are teaching remotely.
- The Ministry of Education, through the General Directorate of Education, the General Directorate of Vocational and Technical Education and the Lebanese University, prepared the regulations and needs necessary to secure diesel for heating and generators and cooperated with the Ministry of Energy, which began distributing diesel to shelters yesterday afternoon.
- The Ministry of Education, in cooperation with organizations, is completing the installation of hot water, additional baths and showers in shelter centers and is preparing to equip the centers with heating means in the coming days
- The Ministry of Education is completing educational activities in shelters in cooperation with educational partners.



The Ministry of Public Health publishes the cumulative report of the support provided to displaced citizens. The Ministry also publishes a regulation linking each of the shelter centers to the primary health care center allocated to it in various Lebanese governorates.

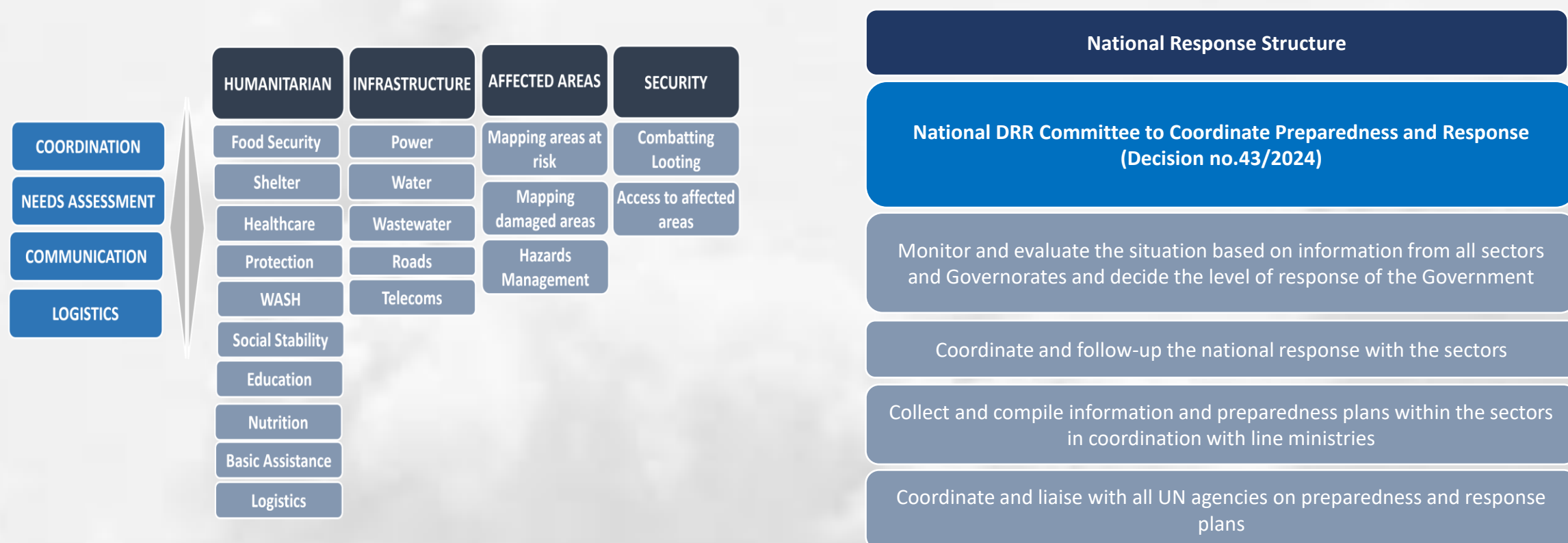
